

This young gentleman was feverely wounded in the late engagement, and though fanguine hopes were at first entertained of his recovery, he has fallen another victim to this unnatural war, unspeakably lamented by his brother officers, and deeply regretted by all here who witnessed his exemplary behaviour and patience under his sufferings, His remains were interred in the burial ground of St. George's Church, to which they were followed by a long train of his Countrymen, of the Officers of the Garrison, of the Navy, and a number of the Gentlemen of the Town. A pathetic and very appropriate discourse was delivered on the occasion by the Rev. Mr. Hudion; and the last honours were paid over the grave of the young officer by a division of the Garrison Battalion.
